



Cancer Incidence in Florida vs US


Age-adjusted cancer incidence rates per 100,000


Cancer Mortality Rates in Florida vs. US

Age-adjusted cancer mortality rates per 100,000






Cancer Lethality in Florida by Cancer Type


Leading Causes of Death in Florida

Age-adjusted Death Rate per 100,000 Floridians in 2015





Cancer Mortality Among States in US *Age-adjusted cancer mortality rates*




Pediatric Cancer Incidence and Mortality in Florida

Florida Cancer Screenings Actual vs 2020 Goals





Cancer Incidence by Florida County




Cancer Mortality by Florida County




Florida Lung Cancer Incidence Before and After Tobacco Cessation and Prevention program launch

Annual Spending for Tobacco-Related Communications in Florida




In 2015, **15.8%** of high school students in **Florida** used an electronic cigarette on at least one day in the past 30 days.


Nationally, 24.1% of high school students used electronic vapor products on at least one day in the past 30 days.

HPV Vaccinations among teenagers age 13-17, by state





HPV Vaccinations

CDC now recommends 11 to 12 year olds get two doses of HPV vaccine - rather than the previously recommended three doses -- to protect against cancers caused by HPV. The second dose should be given 6-12 months after the first dose.


