

NCFCCC CIG UPDATE



Small Town Giant Colon Experience Rationale:

- 9 of the 11 counties in NCFCCC region have a lower percent of adults who met clinical guidelines for colorectal cancer screening than the state average (67.3%)

- Hamilton, Lafayette, Levy, and Union counites experienced higher late-stage colorectal cancer diagnosis than the state.
- Goal 12 of the 2020 2025 Florida Cancer Plan: Reduce colorectal cancer mortality through early detection of colorectal cancer in Floridians

Small Town Giant Colon Experience: Two-Pronged Approach

1: Community Education – utilize giant inflatable colon Providers or CHWs will give a walk-through tour of the colon reviewing each of the 6 stations (normal tissue, benign polyp, Crohn's disease, malignant polyp, colon cancer, and advanced colon cancer). Referrals to primary care providers offering sliding fee scales will be available.

Project Update

On June 7, 2023, NWFCCC in collaboration with Big Bend AHEC conducted a breast cancer screening event at the Leon County Health Department, Tallahassee

Alignment with Cancer Plan

- Cancer prevention and control through reduction or elimination of behavioral risk factors
- Tobacco use cessation



Breast cancer screening and food distribution



- ☐ 25 Women were screened for breast cancer
- ☐ Majority of attendees were Black / African American and Latino women

- Women who went through the screening were also provided food boxes.
- □ AHEC Big Bend distributed pamphlets and brochures about tobacco cessation programs in the catchment area.

- Enrollment in Clinical Trials (Research & Technology Development Disparities)





PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Home radon screening by community paramedics.

ALIGNMENT WITH THE CANCER PLAN:

Goal 9: Reduce radon gas exposure in all Florida households, workplaces, and other buildings.

- PROJECT UPDATES:
 - Identified 3 communities with radon hot spots using FDOH zip data.
 - Created survey to target homes with greatest need and enroll the homeowner for paramedic conducted screening.
 - Promoting survey now on local TV, radio, and social media.
 - Initial screening results will be shared at the next CCRAB meeting.
